5. Landowners and authorized persons must sign an affidavit that the beaver(s) were obtained from within the municipality and that these animal(s) were causing significant flooding or damage at the time of claim.
6. Evidence of Claim will be collected in accordance with attached Schedule "1".
7. Copies of the registration form, affidavit, policy, or further information may be obtained by contacting the Public Works Department at 836-3348.
8. All work and claims are subject to the control of the Director of Public works, Agricultural Fieldman or their designate.
